

LIMITED 12-MONTH WARRANTY FOR BRAILLE AND LOW VISION WATCHES

ILA watches are made of the finest materials and feature precision quartz movements.

We warrant your watch for 12 months against defects in material and workmanship, providing it has received normal use and has been given adequate care.

This warranty does not cover crowns, damage to the watch case, crystal, dial or hands or any problem resulting from abuse or improper use of the watch. It does not cover replacement of batteries or routine cleaning or servicing of the movement.

Braille watches are NOT water-resistant. Low vision watches are NOT designed for swimming or diving. Care should be taken when washing, showering and when walking in the rain. Should the watch accidentally become wet, wipe it dry quickly and do not operate it unless it is dry.

HOW TO START YOUR WATCH

In order to maximize battery life during storage the crown (also called the winding stem) is in the "out" position or it has a plastic guard between the crown and the watch case. This disconnects the watch movement from battery.

To activate the watch, remove the plastic guard, if it has one, leave the crown in the extended position and set to the correct time. Then push the crown in, which will start the watch.
